

Teasel has been added to the Saline County noxious weed list as a “county added noxious weed”. Teasels are a biennial plant which blooms from June through September. Teasel will take over roadsides, pastures and other vacant areas. Digging and herbicide control are the ways to control tease. Mowing will just spread the infestation as the plants will regrow after mowing and mowing spreads the seeds faster.
