

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
OF THE COUNTY OF SALINE, NEBRASKA**

Notice is hereby given that the County of Saline, Nebraska (the “County”) will hold a public hearing on August 16, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. or promptly thereafter in the Saline County Courthouse, 204 S High St., Wilber, Nebraska, regarding the advisability of the proposed issuance by the County, pursuant to a plan of financing in accordance with Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, Sections 13-1101 et seq., as amended, of one or more series of educational facilities revenue bonds, notes, loans or other obligations in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$28,000,000 (the “Obligations”), the proceeds of which Obligations will be loaned to Doane University (the “Borrower”), a Nebraska nonprofit corporation, for the purpose of financing all or a portion of (a) the costs of acquiring, constructing, equipping and furnishing certain facilities to be owned and operated by the Borrower in furtherance of its educational purpose, including (i) a new residence hall, (ii) a new presidential residence and event venue, and (iii) various other capital improvements to the Borrower’s Crete, Nebraska campus, all located or to be located on the Borrower’s Crete, Nebraska campus at 1014 Boswell Avenue in Crete, Nebraska (collectively, the “Projects”), and (b) the costs of financing the Obligations.

Following such public hearing, the Board of Commissioners will consider for adoption a resolution granting public approval to such proposed issuances of the Obligations for the Projects for the purpose of complying with Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

The Obligations shall be limited obligations of the County, and the interest thereon will be payable solely from the revenues derived from one or more loan agreements between the County and the Borrower. The Obligations shall not constitute or give rise to a pecuniary liability of the County, nor shall the Obligations become a charge against its general credit or taxing powers.

At the time and place fixed for the public hearing, all interested persons will be given an opportunity to express their views orally and in writing on the proposed issuance of the Obligations and the location and nature of the Projects.

Persons wishing to make comments in writing about the proposed Obligations and Projects shall do so in advance of the public hearing by submitting such written comments to the Saline County Clerk at 204 S High St., Wilber 68465.
