SALINE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The regular meeting of the Saline County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:40 a.m. on Tuesday, June 11th, 2019 by Chairperson, Marvin A. Kohout. Present were Kohout, Janet J. Henning, Stephanie A. Krivohlavek, Phil Hardenburger, and Russ Karpisek, Commissioners, and Deputy County Clerk Anita Bartels. County Attorney Tad Eickman was present between court commitments.

Notice of said meeting was posted in the County Clerk's Office, on the Saline County Website, and published in all three county newspapers prior to the meeting, in compliance with State Statutes.

Let the record show that all proceedings are electronically recorded.

Kohout advised those present of the open meetings law posted at the back of the room.

Henning moved to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Karpisek, Kohout, Krivohlavek, Henning and Hardenburger, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve the minutes of the May 28th, 2019 meeting, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Hardenburger, Karpisek, Krivohlavek, Henning and Kohout, nays none, motion carried.

Under correspondence, Bartels reported receiving the NIRMA 2019-20 Billing Statement, in the amount of \$248,859 annually, representing a \$19,004 or 8.27% increase; she also received the May 19th minutes of the Saline County Ag Society; notice of the Five Rivers RC&D regular meeting has been rescheduled from June 20th to June 27th; she received from Blue Valley Behavioral Health an \$8,000 budget request for 2019/2020; received from the City of Crete, the June 4th City Council regular meeting minutes and the June 4th meeting agendas for the Crete Public Works, Crete Public Safety Committee, Crete Legislative Development Committee and Crete Parks & Recreation meetings; received a notice of Public Hearing of the Planning Commission and City Council of Crete for the Amendment of the Redevelopment Plan on June 24, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at Crete City Hall; received an email report from Javier Caltenco with the Small Business Administration, statewide, there are 749 loan approved, in the amount of \$39,199,300 and for Saline County there were 2 home loan applications totaling \$48,700.

Discussion was held on the current Saline County General and Public Assistance Guidelines. The consensus was for each Board member to review the current guidelines, along with the NACO Overview of Nebraska's General Assistance Law and discuss further at a later date. Eickman did recommend maintaining control of Saline County General and Public Assistance at the local level.

Veteran Service Officer Forrest Doyle, reported the Veteran Service Committee's Regular Meeting was held on May 16, 2019. Doyle gave a quarterly update of the Veteran Office activities. The next meeting of the Veterans Service Committee Regular Meeting will be September 19, 2019, 7:00 p.m. in the Courthouse Assembly Room.

At 10:34 a.m., Kohout announced that the Board would take a short recess.

At 10:45 a.m., Kohout announced that the Board would reconvene.

Under Report of Officials, Henning attended a Region V meeting on Monday, noting the EPC rate has gone up to \$214.00 and she also attended the Drivers Safety Training.

Hardenburger attended the Drivers Safety Training, the NACO Conference in Kearney, will attend the County Budget Workshop in York and has an upcoming Ag Society and Blue Valley Community Action meeting.

Kohout attended the Drivers Safety Training, the NACO County Board of Equalization Workshop and County Board Workshop in Kearney, will attend the County Budget Workshop in York, has an upcoming Solid Waste Management meeting and notified the Board the next Planning and Zoning meeting will be June 18th at 7:00 p.m.

Krivohlavek reported attending the May 24th Aging Services full board meeting and will attend the June 18th Planning and Zoning meeting.

Karpisek attended a SENDD Budget meeting, the NACO Conference in Kearney and has an Employee Wellness meeting on Thursday.

At 11:00 a.m., Krivohlavek moved to close the bids for gravel, crushed rock and culverts, seconded by Karpisek. Voting aye were Karpisek, Kohout, Krivohlavek, Hardenburger and Henning, nays none, motion carried.

Gravel bids were opened and read from Beatrice Sand & Gravel of Fairbury; Gana Trucking & Excavating, Inc. of Martell; Johnson Sand & Gravel of Columbus; and Rock On of Beatrice. The bids are placed on file and are of public record in the Commissioners' journal as attachments #1, 2, 3 and 4 to these minutes.

Crushed Rock bids were opened and read from Beatrice Sand & Gravel of Beatrice; Gana Trucking and Excavating, Inc. of Martell; and Rock On of Beatrice. The bids are placed on file and are of public record in the Commissioners' journal as attachments #5, 6 and 7 to these minutes.

Culvert bids were opened and read from Midwest Service and Sales Co. of Schuyler; Ace/Eaton Metals of Kearney; and Metal Culverts, Inc. of Jefferson City Mo. The bids are placed on file and are of public record in the Commissioners' journal as attachments #8, 9 and 10 to these minutes.

Asst. Highway Superintendent, Bill Slezak thanked the bidders and announced all bids would be reviewed and the Roads Dept. would come back to the Board on June 25th at 11:00 a.m., with their recommendation.

Slezak presented a request to Occupy County Right-of-Way by EDF/Milligan 1 Wind LLC. Before acting on this request, the Board is requesting additional information from the Highway Superintendent Bruce Filipi. This right of way request was postponed until the June 25, 2019 meeting.

Slezak reported the Bridge Project C76(753), C007604215P, will be pushed until November 2019, with a finished date of March 2020. Herbst Construction was awarded an Emergency Relief Bridge Project in Pierce County. Area land owners near this bridge have been contacted and have no issues with this change.

Slezak updated the Board on current road and bridge projects taking place.

Henning moved to approve the Clerk of the District Court Report of Fees for May in the amount of \$25,056.26, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Kohout, Krivohlavek, Hardenburger, Henning and Karpisek, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve the Sheriff's Report of Fees for May, mileage \$1,810.25 and writ fees \$1,896.00 totaling \$3,706.25, seconded by Karpisek. Voting aye were Krivohlavek, Hardenburger, Henning, Karpisek and Kohout, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve the County Clerk's Report of Fees for May in the amount of \$13,933.25, seconded by Hardenburger. Voting aye were Hardenburger, Henning, Karpisek, Kohout and Krivohlavek, nays none, motions carried.

Henning moved to approve resolution #2019-042, transferring \$4,150.00 from the General Fund to the Reappraisal Fund, as proposed in the 2018-19 budget, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Henning, Karpisek, Kohout, Krivohlavek and Hardenburger, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve resolution #2019-043, transferring \$25,000.00 from the General Fund to the Road and Bridge Fund, to be reimbursed when funds are available, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Karpisek, Kohout, Krivohlavek, Hardenburger and Henning, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve resolution #2019-044, transferring \$1,400.00 from the General Fund to the Juvenile Services Aid Program Fund to be reimbursed when funds become available, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Kohout, Krivohlavek, Hardenburger, Henning and Karpisek, nays none, motion carried.

Krivohlavek moved to approve the claims as presented, seconded by Henning. Voting aye were Krivohlavek, Hardenburger, Henning, Karpisek and Kohout, nays none, motion carried.
