



Saline County Board Minutes



SALINE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The regular meeting of the Saline County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:32 a.m. on Tuesday, July 20, 2021 by Chairperson Russ Karpisek. Present were Karpisek, Janet J. Henning, Philip Hardenburger and Stephanie A. Krivohlavek Commissioners, and County Clerk Anita K. Bartels; County Attorney Tad Eickman was present between court commitments. Commissioner Marvin A. Kohout was absent.

Notice of said meeting was posted in the County Clerk's Office, on the Saline County Website, and published in all three county newspapers on July 14, 2021, in compliance with State Statutes.

Let the record show that all proceedings are electronically recorded.

Karpisek advised those present of the open meetings act posted at the back of the room.

Henning moved to approve the agenda with the deletion of item to discuss/approve the 1% increase in restricted fund limitation for the 2021-2022 budget year, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Krivohlavek, Hardenburger, Henning and Karpisek, nays none, motion carried.

Hardenburger moved to approve the minutes of the July 6, 2021 meeting, seconded by Henning. Voting aye were Hardenburger, Henning, Karpisek, and Krivohlavek, nays none, motion carried.

Under Correspondence, Bartels reported receiving from the Saline County Historical Society, the minutes of their June 26, 2021 meeting; from the City of Crete their July 20th agendas for the City Council, Public Safety, Public Works, Finance, Legislative Development and Parks & Recreation committees.

Hardenburger reported receiving a call from Brad Swiggert inquiring if the Commissioners would consider forming a committee to investigate insurance options.

Under Report of Officials, Hardenburger reported attending an Ag Society Meeting;

Karpisek reported joining Brandi Kelly and Daryl Clark from the Assessor's office to do a field visit regarding a protest hearing. He also spoke of the positive forward movement Brandi Klaassen is making with the Wellness Program.

Nathan Mueller from the Saline County Extension Office explained to the Board how mileage reimbursement requests are being submitted to the Counties covered by the surrounding area Extension Offices.

Treasurer Debbie Spanyers presented the Semi-Annual Statement for period ending June 30, 2021. Krivohlavek moved to approve, seconded by Henning. Voting aye were Henning, Karpisek, Krivohlavek and Hardenburger, nays none, motion carried.

Spanyers also reported on the Investment Listing and Pledged Collateral Listing for period ending June 30, 2021.

Henning moved to approve the June 2021 Clerk fees in the amount of \$23,883.00, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Karpisek, Krivohlavek, Hardenburger and Henning, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve the Sheriff fees in the amount of \$3,152.97, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Krivohlavek, Hardenburger, Henning and Karpisek, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to approve Resolution #2021-046, transferring \$2,500.00 from the Inheritance Fund to the Juvenile Services Aid Program Fund to be reimbursed when funds become available, seconded by Hardenburger. Voting aye were Hardenburger, Henning, Karpisek and Krivohlavek, nays none, motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Bruce Filipi presented a request to occupy right of way #WO71501008100272, PR-2106 from Windstream for a new residence at County Road 2500. Henning moved to approve, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Henning, Karpisek, Krivohlavek and Hardenburger, nays none, motion carried.

Filipi updated the Board on a bridge replacement with a culvert southeast of Friend, and various other road projects.

Filipi did advise the property by Crete, the County is looking to sell, needs to be advertised and a public hearing held. Eickman and Bartels will work on getting this scheduled.

At 10:18 a.m. the Board recessed;

At 10:30 a.m. the Board reconvened;

Jerad Reimers, Community Liaison for Congressman Adrian Smith joined the Board meeting via teleconference. Reimers presented an update on the legislative bills and committees Congressman Smith was



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working with. He advised the Board currently there are no clear answers regarding the spending of ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) funds. It is extremely complex at the Federal Level.

Regarding the ARPA funds, Eickman recommended the Board check the U.S. Treasury website for specific reasons and permissions before spending any of the ARPA monies.

Henning moved to approve the claims as presented with the addition of a mileage claim in the amount of \$325.92 to be paid to Nathan Mueller, seconded by Hardenburger. Voting aye were Karpisek, Krivohlavek, Hardenburger and Henning, nays none, motion carried.
