



Saline Board of Equalization Minutes



SALINE COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The regular meeting of the Saline County Board of Equalization opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was called to order at 9:15 a.m. on Tuesday, February 18th, 2020, by Chairperson, Marvin A. Kohout. Present were Stephanie A. Krivohlavek, Janet J. Henning, Kohout and Russ Karpisek, Commissioners, County Clerk Daryl Fikar and Administrative Assistant Tim McDermott. Commissioner Philip S. Hardenburger was absent.

Notice of said meeting was posted in the County Clerk's office, on the Saline County Website, and published in all county newspapers prior to the meeting, in compliance with State Statutes.

Let the record show that all proceedings are electronically recorded.

Kohout advised those present of the open meetings law posted at the back of the room.

Henning moved to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Karpisek, Kohout, Henning and Krivohlavek, nays none, motion carried.

Karpisek moved to approve the minutes of the February 4th, 2020 meeting as presented, seconded by Henning. Voting aye were Karpisek, Henning, Kohout and Krivohlavek, nays none, motion carried.

Under correspondence, Fikar reported receiving a notice from the Fillmore County Zoning Department of a scheduled hearing to consider changes to the Fillmore County zoning regulations. The Fillmore County Joint Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on February 18th at 8:00 p.m. and the same issue will be before the Fillmore County Supervisors on February 25th at 9:15 a.m.

County Assessor Brandi Kelly presented tax list correction #2020-09. She explained that the Nebraska Department of Revenue had notified her office that their audit reveals that the homestead exemption of the south 11 feet of lot 30 and all of lot 29 and the north 33' of lot 28 in Horacek's Addition to the City of Wilber will be reduced from 100% to 60%. Henning moved to approve the correction, seconded by Karpisek. Voting aye were Henning, Kohout, Krivohlavek and Karpisek, nays none, motion carried.

Henning moved to open the public hearing for motor vehicle tax exemptions, seconded by Krivohlavek. Voting aye were Henning, Kohout, Krivohlavek and Karpisek, nays none, motion carried.

County Treasurer Debbie Spanyers presented motor vehicle tax exemption application for a 2009 Toyota Corolla owned by Schoenstatt Sisters of Mary, used exclusively for religious purposes.

Krivohlavek moved to close the public hearing for motor vehicle tax exemptions, seconded by Karpisek. Voting aye were Karpisek, Henning, Kohout and Krivohlavek, nays none, motion carried.

Krivohlavek moved to approve the motor vehicle tax exemption application. The motion was seconded by Henning. Voting aye were Kohout, Krivohlavek, Karpisek and Henning, nays none, motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:29 a.m. The next regular meeting will be on March 3rd, 2020, at 9:15 a.m. in the Saline County Commissioners' Room, Court House, Wilber NE.
